

Carlsbad Softball Association 8U Liaison

Description of Position:

The 8U Liaison is responsible for being the point of contact for the 8U managers regarding issues such as schedules, rules, playoffs and available clinics.

Reporting Relationships: Reports directly to the Manager Coordinator. The 8U liaison works with Player's Agent, Scheduler, Equipment Manager, 6U Liaison and Jr. Umpire Coordinator.

Time requirements:

- Attend a quarterly board meeting as necessary during the spring season.
- Approximately 3-4 hours to attend T-Ball Fun Day.
- Approximately 30-60 minutes per week to keep CSA 8U managers up to date on schedule changes, or deal with other related issues.

Season Schedule:

December: Attend T-Ball Fun Day.

Attend 8U player evaluation and team selection meeting.

January: Assist Player's Agent with team formation, uniform and schedule distribution if necessary.

February-April: Deal with 8U issues as necessary.

April: Disseminate 8U playoff rules.

Assist All-Star Coordinator with 8U all-star selection.

Individual Tasks:

- Attend T-Ball Fun Day and evaluate 2nd year 6U players for Advanced Placement.
- Help with player evaluations and player draft.
- Distribute 8U rules to managers.
- Be available to Player's Agent to assist with uniform distribution or related tasks.
- Organize 1-2 Manager's clinics prior or during the season.
- Be available to answer questions of 8U managers and parents.
- Disseminate 8U playoff schedule and rules.
- Help facilitate 8U all-star selections.
