

## Carlsbad Softball Association Umpire-In-Chief

### Description of Position:

The Umpire in Chief is responsible for contacting MOA or other umpire organizations to get umpires scheduled for spring season games and for the Seabreeze Tournament.

### Reporting Relationships:

The Umpire in Chief reports directly to the League Coordinator and interacts with the League Scheduler, Jr. Umpire Coordinator, Vice President and Seabreeze Coordinator.

### Time requirements:

- Attend a quarterly Board meeting.
- Approximately 2 hours prior to the season working with the League Scheduler.
- Optional: Attend 2 eight hour umpire clinics-Rules and Mechanics.
- Approximately 1-2 hours per week interacting with MOA or other umpire association regarding scheduling conflicts and 14U scheduling.
- Approximately 3-4 hours prior to the Seabreeze Tournament working with Seabreeze Coordinator to schedule umpire coverage.

### Season Schedule:

January-Work with League Scheduler to prepare schedule and contact MOA with schedule.

February-Optional: Attend umpire rules clinic

March-Optional: Attend umpire mechanics clinic

May-Work with Seabreeze Tournament Director and League Scheduler to schedule umpires for Seabreeze.

### Individual Tasks:

- Email and phone MOA scheduler
- Work with League Scheduler to prepare schedule
- Contact other umpire organizations for umpires when necessary.
